On the annual observance of the International Day of Persons with Disabilities (IDPD), December 3rd 2022, EUC organised its first multiplier event for the project hosted at the European University Cyprus. DIGI READY achieved a major milestone by publishing the Good Practices Catalogue on digital inclusion in VET. The Catalogue is a collection and analysis of practices that were incorporated within the education sector in Europe during the COVID-19 pandemic to overcome challenges to inclusion online.
